REGISTRATIONS TO BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 1ST

RULES:

1. This PIONEERING SKILLS EVENT is open to all registered Scouts & Venturers
2. Rafts are to be ready to race for 10:00 am start. Judging will be PRIOR to the race
3. Standard raft materials: Wood spars, rope, string/twine, cardboard cartons and plastic. Duct tape may be used to assist in waterproofing, **but not in place of proper lashings**. Canoe or boat paddles may be used. **Rafts using only standard materials will be eligible for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Race Trophies.**
4. Rafts using non-standard materials i.e.: plastic drums, sono tubes, mechanical fasteners (nails, etc.) or sawn lumber, will be a separate category with a single trophy.
5. Groups may enter as many rafts as they wish. ALL rafts MUST be constructed in the current year.
6. All members of the Troop or Company may help with the construction. **Only 2 riders per craft.**
7. All riders **must supply & wear** an approved Life Jacket or PFD and footwear. (What lurks in the mighty Speed?)
8. Rafts will be judged on strength, streamline, inventiveness and workmanship.
9. Group Leaders are responsible for event appropriate paperwork.
10. After the race, **ALL** rafts (and materials) **must be removed** from the water by the respective groups. We CANNOT leave anything laying around, or behind.
11. You MUST preregister by mail, phone, or email. You MAY bring payment on the day of the race.
